I am talking about uniforms, shoes, socks polar fleeces etc and maybe food parcels, firewood and or maybe things that you are finding hard to get direction or help with. If you are struggling to get food for your child's breakfast or lunch or snacks at our school, then please do not hesitate to contact or email me.

After all we are told every day what a magnificent job we are doing, and we are all supposed to be doing all we can, to ensure that none of our citizens are suffering.

Do you have a business that needs workers or workers that are looking for jobs and we may be able to put you on to something or someone?

We are still in Covid 19 Level 2 and with that still have some restrictions in place.

- HEALTH AND SAFETY DIRECTIVE You are required to sign in and check in at the office during school hours and not just wander down to classrooms. Teachers are unavailable for meetings during class time. Please make an appointment through the office 07 3788097
- No unauthorized entry into our school Staff and Students allowed onsite with Contractors and parents required to sign in
- Students who are checking out during the school day need to be checked through our office system

- MINISTRY OF EDUCATION LEGISLATIVE REQUIREMENT ALL ABSENCES need clarification and or Justification by Parents / Caregivers. Absences are recorded on our Ministry Data base so you will need to contact us as to why the absence has occurred.
- Health and Hygiene protocols are paramount
- HEALTH AND SAFETY DIRECTIVE DON'T use the driveway into the school in the morning and afterschool as we have 10 x buses picking up and dropping off from this entrance each day as well as students walking into schools.
- If you feel unwell then stay home. We have had too many students being sent to school not feeling well then having to be picked.
 We have had a 'tummy bug' come into our school and we are asking that anyone with symptoms

We have had a 'tummy bug' come into our school and we are asking that anyone with symptoms associated with sickness and nausea to stay off our site.

- Students who are not observing set protocols will be sent home on Stand down and we also are expecting that if their behaviour becomes a problem, we will also be sending students home.

We are in an unprecedented predicament and under pressure to adhere to the guidelines laid down by the Ministry of Health and Education and the expectation of our parents and community without having to deal with challenging behaviours as well.

Under level 2 we deem this to be unacceptable and will require your child to undertake more online or "distant" education.
