Once installed you will be asked to make up a 4 digit pin then enter your Edge email and password.

In the app there is a series of labelled tiles that when tapped bring up information on your child's contact details, timetable, attendance,



achievement and related data. We will also push announcements and notifications to the app. We would like you to send 'Notify School of Absence' notifications to the school. After 3 minutes of non-use the Edge app will log out
